

HISTORICAL DRILL INTERSECTIONS








Rock Geochemistry in the Gavilanes Zone






Panoramic photograph of **San Nicolas-Descubridora** mineralized zone looking south. The mineralized structures are marked in red line.

Exploration Plans



Descubridora zone, emplaced rhyolitic dyke in andesites with associated gold veining.

- Phase 1 to complete 3,000 meters of step-out drilling from the identified resource.
